Greetings from the Lincoln Diocese Cursillo Movement... Christ loves each of you and continues to count on you!! Given that Cursillo is based on friendship, it's always good to hear from each of you. We've recently heard from some regarding name and address changes, as well as sharing significant experiences at friendship grouping, Ultreyas, and in your environments. Some have also asked how they can increase their participation in Cursillo activities.

Please be assured that your time and talents are most welcome! We are actively seeking volunteers to help with the work of Cursillo in a variety of ways, most importantly by offering Palanca. And because Cursillo is a lived experience, we always need cursillistas who are willing to share about the ways that God is working in their lives by serving as team members on Weekends (either giving rollos or being an auxiliary), giving witnesses at Ultreya, giving a talk at School of Leaders, or sharing with their group members in friendship groups. Other ways to further Cursillo's goal of bringing Christ into the world include helping on the Service Team or providing food/snacks for the upcoming Three Day Weekends (Women's: April 30 – May 3 in Hebron; Men's: June 11-14 in Doniphan), coming to the Closings for each of the Weekends (May 3 for the Women and June 14 for the Men) to welcome the new cursillistas to their Fourth Day, serving as a Secretariat member, participating in the School of Leaders (another group reunion), or helping with other Cursillo activities throughout the year (e.g., the annual Fourth Day Retreat or Grand Ultreya or putting out the newsletter).

In addition, sponsoring a candidate for the Weekend is a wonderful means of helping to sustain Cursillo and at the same time, bringing a friend closer to Christ. Have you identified through prayer and personal contact which of your friend(s) you should sponsor for the upcoming Weekends? What some have described as a "best kept secret" should be shared so others can experience a deeper encounter with Christ.
