


#### **PALANCA for the Upcoming Weekends**

#### From the Lay Director

The message woven throughout the spiritual rollos and chapel meditations was also presented. All of us were able to meditate on the message of the Three Days, as it builds from beginning to end, and in a sense, we were able to re-kindle the fire of wanting to help build the Kingdom in the places God put us. We were reminded of the beauty of the message and purpose of Cursillo, and how living Cursillo in our daily lives DOES make a difference – to us and to those around us.

The 2017 Cursillo Weekends are scheduled to be held in McCook at St. Patrick School: Men's – March 16-19, 2017; Women's – March 23-26, 2017. Have you been thinking of someone to invite to a Cursillo? If so, ask now and get them ready for what (really Who) they will encounter. The best preparation is your living the 4th Day, and they will want what you have. Get the applications in early … walk with your candidates in the Precursillo … through the Cursillo Weekend … and into the Postcursillo. Call or email if you have questions.

#### From the Spiritual Advisor

Every so often it is helpful for each of us to do some personal reflection and ask ourselves how we are doing in our spiritual lives. Some questions that each of us might ask ourselves are: How has Cursillo helped me? In what ways is my life better since I lived my Three Day Weekend? How am I living my Fourth Day? Am I in a regular Friendship Group Reunion? Am I going to Ultreya? Are there others with whom I am friends (or would like to be friends) who I should invite to live a Three Day Weekend?

The purpose of the Three Day Weekend is to move a person from the Precursillo to the Postcursillo, and, in the process, give them the tools they need to live the Postcursillo (the Fourth Day). In order to live our Fourth Day well, we need to be using the tools of Group Reunion and Ultreya. It has been said that an isolated cursillista is a paralyzed cursillista, and similarly, an isolated Group Reunion is a paralyzed Group Reunion. In other words, if we are not meeting with others in a regular Group Reunion, and if we are not gathering in Ultreya, then we as cursillistas can become paralyzed, closed in on ourselves rather than sharing our lives with others and encouraging others, as well as being encouraged ourselves. In both (Friendship Group Reunion and Ultreya), we share our Piety, Study, and Action, and that reinforces our faith and also helps strengthen the faith of others ... it is a wonderful means of helping us and others to remain always hopeful.

Recent Popes and other spiritual leaders have been encouraging Catholics to be a part of the New Evangelization. That means that we look outside of ourselves and use the gifts and talents that God has given us to bring others closer to Christ. Though the New Evangelization has been much talked about in recent years, there are not as many Catholic men and women who are actually talking about Christ. Cursillo is a great tool to help us do just that ... being strengthened in our Group Reunions and Ultreya, we <u>want</u> to truly live our faith and help others to know Christ as we do ... we want to share with others that our joy and peace come from our ever-growing relationship with Christ (and His Church). It should be a natural "bubbling over" from our own lived experience and seeking to be with our Lord in eternity ... and we can begin to live our heaven right here right now (which is a relatively short period of time) in anticipation of being with Him in eternity once our earthly life has ended (and that will be forever).

If the men or women who were on the Rollo Team or on the Service Team for the Weekend that you lived had not been living their Fourth Day and had not been willing to share their time, their friendship, and their experience of Cursillo, then you would not have been able to experience your Three Day Weekend. Please pray about and consider helping with the upcoming Three Day Weekends and with the work of Cursillo in general. For example, would you be willing to help keep Ultreya active in your area (that means simply setting a time and finding a location ... then inviting, inviting, inviting)? If you don't have a Friendship Group Reunion, ask me or any other cursillista to help you find one. Be a part of Ultreya ... it's amazing to see cursillistas you don't see on a regular basis, re-kindling friendships and being interested in one another's lives. And as has been mentioned before, School of Leaders (SOL) is yet another form of reunion ... it's reunion with the purpose of helping Cursillo to be an effective tool of the New Evangelization. What a gift that God lets us be part of His great work!! So, how ARE you doing in your spiritual life? Cursillo can help ...


