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What is PALANCA?

Today, perhaps more than ever, it is necessary to remind ourselves that without God we can do nothing. In his pastoral letter on the Cursillo, Bishop Hervas says: “We should have the intimate and absolute conviction that everything in the Cursillo is the work of God’s grace. It is necessary, therefore, to pray and make sacrifices for its apostolic success. The miracles of God’s grace are granted by trusting prayer, accompanied by sacrifice: not by knowledge or experience.”

Writing a Palanca letter is one means of communicating the Palanca currently being done, but the letter itself is not the Palanca. In fact, Palanca can be done for a particular purpose without writing a letter at all. Sacrifice is part and parcel of the Christian life, whether or not we tell someone that we are making a sacrifice for another. If the Movement quit emphasizing the importance of sacrifice, it would not be Christ-centered. We should really be living the spirit of Palanca each day.

Thus, Palanca offerings should not be limited to the Three Days. The selection of candidates, the study of environments, the growth of Group Reunions, Ultreyas and especially the work of Secretariats and the School of Leaders depend mostly on authentic and generous Palanca offered by all. Each one should offer something; each one should offer themselves. St. Paul reminds us in Romans 12:1, “Offer yourselves as a living and holy sacrifice which is pleasing unto Him.” Offering ourselves in whatever way needed should be our real Palanca.

Christ is counting on YOU!! Please offer Palanca for the spiritual success of this and every Cursillo activity. After all, Palanca is the backbone of the Cursillo Movement and essential for each spiritual success - on Weekends as well as in every Fourth Day. 2. Precursillo and Three Days

Recall that in the **PRECURSILLO** we identify, befriend, and help someone who is “searching” for “something” that they think is happiness or fulfillment, but which we know is really “Somebody”-- Jesus Christ. A Three Day Cursillo Weekend is one way of trying to direct their search, if they are open to it, toward the three essential encounters (self, Christ and others). In this way, we make their previous unrest become the very motivating force for their newfound enthusiasm, for a sincere and hopeful conversion.

The work of Precursillo (making a friend, being a friend, and bringing your friend to Christ) can be quick and easy, or it may be slow and time-consuming. The key is to begin the work, always in a spirit of Palanca (talking to God about your friend before talking to your friend about God), and with a mind/heart/will set “to the highest level” to persevere in winning this person for Christ (for CHRIST, not for CURSILLO).

The work of the Precursillo stands alone; however, sometimes the friendship may lead to your sponsoring your friend on a **THREE DAY WEEKEND**. The goal of the Weekend is to focus the candidate's unrest, and with the Grace of God, this can be achieved. If Cursillo could help your friend better know that God loves him/her, then invite your friend to live a Cursillo Weekend. Or, consider inviting your friend to your Group Reunion (with the permission of the other members of your friendship group) and/or an Ultreya ... let your friend experience first-hand what helps you persevere in your everyday life (the friendship and the faith boost). You shouldn't wait until right before the Weekend to make and be friends, and in fact, the friendship shouldn't even be centered on getting the person to a Cursillo Weekend. But always remember that in all you do for our Lord, be excited and joy-filled and enthusiastic ... if you aren't, why should they be?

You might ask yourself the question -- *Did Cursillo help me to grow in my spiritual life?* If so, why wouldn't I want that same opportunity/gift for another? If **you** don't invite your friend, who will? If you know of persons who are hungry to know our Lord better, and who want to grow in their spiritual lives, invite them to live a Three Day Weekend. With the Winter Weekends fast approaching, think about the people God put in your path (your environment) that He would like to know Him better. Is there someone He is asking you to invite and walk with? Please pray about this and ask Him ... then follow His prompting.

The **upcoming Three Day Weekends** are scheduled to be held at St. Mary Parish in Sutton on the following dates:

Registration materials were included in the January-February 2016 Newsletter and are also available on the Lincoln Diocese Cursillo webpage. And offer Palanca, not only for your friend, but also for the spiritual success of the Weekends. Consider sending a general Palanca letter for the candidates and team to read during the Weekend. Palanca is a powerful means of opening hearts and minds to hear what God wants to tell us, and the candidates and team will surely benefit from your Palanca offered on their behalf.

Finally, PLEASE consider coming to the Closings ... it is important to the new cursillistas and it will give your spirit a boost as well ... Christ is counting on you!! It gives them hope and encouragement as they go back to their environments. Consider sending a general Palanca letter for the candidates and team to read during the Weekend. Palanca has a powerful means of opening hearts and minds to hear what God wants to tell us, and the women will surely benefit from your Palanca offered on their behalf.

Consider Bishop Conley's words about Cursillo:

"The Cursillo Movement in the Diocese of Lincoln has my blessing and full support. For many, making a Cursillo retreat can be a trigger moment for a deeper conversion of life and a greater commitment to discipleship in the Lord. The Church is gifted with disciples from the Cursillo Movement who are true evangelists. As Pope Francis stated in Evangelii Gaudium, "Jesus wants evangelizers who proclaim the good news not only with words, but above all by a life transfigured by God's presence" (EG 259). Cursillo retreats provide the opportunity for a heart to heart encounter with Christ, whose abundant love and mercy is transformative. Once transformed by a deep encounter with Christ, those involved in the Cursillo movement persevere in this grace through a life of prayer, regular participation in the Sacraments, and fidelity to the "fourth day." The ready support of fellow Cursillo members and attendance at community reunions are a tremendous help as well. May God grant the Diocese of Lincoln many fruitful Cursillos and a great harvest of souls who have their hearts set on our Lord Jesus!"

- In the **Postcursillo**, the person follows Christ. It is here that we daily live what is fundamental for being Christian.

From the Lay Director

The Men's Rollo Team has been preparing for the upcoming Men's Cursillo Weekend. The formation process is not just an exercise of preparation, practicing, and studying. It is more of an encounter with the Cursillo itself, an immersion in the decades-old charism of the Movement. Eduardo Bonnin knew that each of us is called "to be a living witness of the Gospel", and the structure of the Cursillo is founded on that very calling. It is the mission of the Church to spread the Gospel, and thus, it is also the

mission of every baptized person. As we study the Movement, we study the mission of the layperson. As laity, our mission is in the world – our own small part of the larger world that God has given us to be in. This is nothing new in the life of the Church, and many of the movements share this same mission. For me and others who embrace the charism of the Cursillo, Cursillo has shown itself to be a really great way to live the mission entrusted to the lay faithful. All I have learned and studied and experienced in the Cursillo has helped me want to be Christ in the world and spread His message – the best message – that God loves us and wants us to be with Him forever.

In our Group Reunions and Ultreyas, we walk with our friends. Pope Francis said “spiritual accompaniment must lead others closer to God”, and we know, by experience, especially through the Cursillo, that this is true. I cannot imagine my life without this community of faith. It starts with family and spreads out to others, then returns home again. This circle is centered on God and is nourished by Him. My closest friends are cursillistas. We walk the same path and share the same hope. I am so nourished at the Ultreyas when such good friends, united in Christ, come together and share our love for God, our holy Catholic faith, and each other. I pray daily that all cursillistas will embrace the love of Christ and desire to be part of the community they experienced on the 3-Day Weekend.

May God truly bless you for your Palanca for the work of Cursillo. Please go to your Ultreya – someone there needs to see you, and you will find that you need them, too. There you will experience over and over the community of faith we all knew during the 3-Day Weekend. If there is not an Ultreya near you, consider a road trip with some friends. Make that phone call, grab someone after Mass, reach out. Take note of when the School of Leaders is and try to come, you will be glad you did ... it’s yet another community of faith and mission. Cursillo needs all of us – Cursillo needs you. Please come to the Cursillo Weekend Closings (St. Mary Church in Sutton, 5pm: Men’s – February 28; Women’s – April 3). May God bless you!

From the Spiritual Advisor

Many parishes in the Lincoln Diocese gave the book Rediscover Jesus by Matthew Kelly as a Christmas gift. Hopefully, you put your gift to good use as a “*guide to a forty-day spiritual journey, reading a chapter a day*” (as Matthew Kelly suggests).

If you started reading Rediscover Jesus on Christmas Day, you would have finished the forty chapters on February 2. A lot of people think of February 2 as “Groundhog’s Day,” but its greater significance is being the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple, the 40th day of Christmas. The words of a prayer that the priest prays at the

Mass on this feast speak about “*encountering Christ*” ... “*recognizing Him in the breaking of the bread, until He comes again.*” How fitting to have spent the last forty days in a pilgrimage of rediscovering Jesus ... deepening your relationship with Him ... by daily being provided: (1) a point to ponder, (2) a verse to live, (3) a question to consider, and (4) a prayer.

If you were able to make that “*forty-day spiritual journey*,” I hope you now have a deeper relationship with Jesus. If you were not, you have another opportunity as Lent begins on Ash Wednesday (February 10). And, even if you have already read the book and reflected on Who Jesus is, Lent is a time of special grace during which you might further deepen and nourish your spiritual life by making the journey again.

Most people know that Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent, which is a forty-day period of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving meant to prepare us to celebrate the Paschal Mystery at Easter. Matthew Kelly has extended an invitation to “*have the best Lent ever*” by signing up for a daily email that will provide participants with a reflection on each of the forty chapters of Rediscover Jesus. It’s tempting to dismiss his invitation because “I read the book once” or “I already know Jesus”, but did you really spend the time reflecting on Who Jesus is and your relationship with Him? No matter how strong or weak our relationship with the Lord is, it can be better. Lent is a good time to make a commitment to our Lord to spend time each day reading, praying, listening to Him, and truly opening your heart to allow Him to draw you into a deeper relationship with Him.

As we deepen our relationship with Jesus ... as our love grows ... we will naturally want to share this love with others. We need to invite them to encounter Jesus, too. This might on first glance seem difficult. But we’re called to bring Christ quite naturally to all of the places that we go and to all the people that we meet. Each of us interacts each day with a variety of people in a variety of settings as we go about the normal activities of our daily lives. Many of these people do not know Jesus and are not connected to any church. We might think people will be upset with us if we talk about Jesus, or we might be discouraged by the sheer number of people who are un-churched or who don’t know Jesus, thinking that we can’t begin to make a dent. However, remember that God can do ALL things!! When you were presented with your crucifix during the Closing of your Three Day Weekend, the Spiritual Advisor told you that “Christ is counting on you” ... and you responded, “And I am counting on Him”. As we “rediscover Jesus”, growing more in love with Him as we do, we count on Him to help us live our daily lives in such a way that others will want to know Him, too. That’s our cue to invite our friends to meet our Friend ... Jesus. They may be discovering Jesus for the very first time, and thank God that you weren’t afraid to introduce the two!!
