From the Lay Director

Four cursillistas from the Lincoln Diocese participated in the 2016 National Cursillo Encounter at Lewis University in Romeoville, Illinois (August 4-7, 2016). There were 84 cursillistas from our region (Region VI), representing dioceses from Nebraska, Minnesota, Kansas, Missouri, and North and South Dakota. Over 700 cursillistas were at the Encounter – quite an event!

The focus of this Encounter was "Kerygma and Cursillo", with talks on "Kerygma and Precursillo", "Kerygma and the 3-Day Cursillo", and "Kerygma and Postcursillo". Bishop Carlos A. Sevilla, S.J., our National Episcopal Advisor, gave the keynote address, explaining what kerygma is ("an appealing proclamation directly aimed at conversion") and Cursillo's joyful message of the Good News that God in Jesus Christ loves us! The other talks wove the proclamation through each phase of the Cursillo, ending with our living the 4th Day as we continue to grow as Christians through Piety, Study, and Action. We are called to proclaim the Gospel through personal contact and friendship; we love others because God first loved us. Our goal is not only to get to Heaven, but to bring along as many as we can, spreading the message to all those God puts in our path ... in our environments.

Our annual Fourth Day Retreat will be Saturday, October 15, 2016 at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish in North Platte. It will start with 8:30am Mass and end no later than 4:30pm (there will be dinner after the Parish's 5:00pm Mass for those who choose to stay). Please try to come ... you will be glad you did!! Carpool – it is a great way to spend time with other cursillistas, catching up and sharing. If you cannot be there for the whole day, come for whatever time you can. The registration form is in this newsletter. If you are unable to attend, please pray and offer Palanca for the retreat.

From the Spiritual Advisor

In a recent pilgrimage to Poland, I visited the Church of the Mother of God, the Queen of Poland – the Lord's Ark in Nowa-Huta. The town of Nowa-Huta was built by the Communists after World War II as a town without a Church. The Polish people in the town wanted a Church and erected a cross where they wanted a Church to be built. Finally in 1967, permission was given to build a Church. It took 10 years to build. The Church is built in the shape of an Ark. The exterior of the Church is made with rocks the size of what we would call "river rocks". These rocks were gathered by the Polish parishioners and brought to the building site, and then they were used in the construction of the exterior of the Church.

The building of this Church shows the deep faith of the Polish people. Even when they were told there would be no Church in town, they wanted one, so they gave of their time to gather the rocks and worked to build a Church. That is a faith that is lived! We would do well to imitate that faith in our own lives and in our own country.

As cursillistas, we are called to Christianize our environments and to make a friend, be a friend, and bring our friend to Christ. Even when the world and the culture around us are not favorable to the faith, we are called to live our faith and to use our time, talent, and treasure to build up the Church, the Mystical Body of Christ. One way to encourage others is to continue (or begin again) to meet in a Friendship Group Reunion and also go to Ultreya. Another option is to participate in the Fourth Day Retreat on October 15, 2016, at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish in North Platte, and/or the Cursillo de Cursillos in Victoria, KS (Salina Diocese) on November 3-6, 2016. All of these are ways to deepen your understanding of the Cursillo Movement, that you might better live your life for Christ.

The retreat officially begins on <u>Saturday morning (October 15)</u> with Morning Prayer/Mass at 8:30am, so you should plan to arrive in time to settle in prior to that (the facility will open by 7:00am). The facility will also be open on <u>Friday evening (October 14)</u> beginning at 7:00pm for those who want to gather for fellowship and/or have a distance to travel and would like to spend the night (Cursillo-style sleeping accomodations). If you plan on spending Friday night at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, we <u>MUST</u> know (for sleeping arrangements). The retreat will <u>conclude</u> no later than 4:30pm on Saturday; the parish has an anticipatory Mass at 5:00pm. The retreat will include Saturday morning Mass, mediation and prayer, and talks by laypersons and priests. The retreat is intended to build up our spiritual lives by helping us reflect on how God calls us to accept our part in building His Kingdom right where we are ... He asks something of each of us ... what is it He is callling you to? Maybe this retreat will help you better know what our Lord is asking of you.

Saturday includes breakfast, lunch, and supper (after Mass). The suggested donation is \$20.00 per person to cover costs associated with the retreat (e.g., meals, a donation for facility usage, supplies, etc.); however, if finances are tight, give what you are able. Please make check payable to "Cursillo of Lincoln" and mail it in with this form. We need to know if you are coming so we can plan for food.

Please bring the following with you to the retreat (if you have them):

- Pilgrim's Guide (we will bring extras if you need one)
- Other spiritual aids (rosary, etc.)
- ✓ If you come Friday evening to spend the night, the accommodations will be "classic" Cursillo style (mats, dorm-type sleeping, etc.; NO showers). Don't forget <u>WE NEED TO KNOW</u> if you are going to spend the night Friday.
- Please bring a snack or dessert to share, if you like.

Cursillo de Cursillos (Beyond Cursillos) was developed by Eduardo Bonnin to give Cursillistas a deeper understanding of the foundational charism; the mentality, essence, methodology and purpose of the movement.

This inspiring, three-day, workshop has a more relaxed atmosphere than a 3-Day Cursillo Weekend and includes time for questions, sharing and meditation.

It runs Thursday evening through Sunday afternoon. A team from Regional/National presents living, personal experiences during rollos and meditations based on the Cursillo book entitled *Structure of Ideas* to help encourage on-going conversion through encounters with God, oneself, and others.

CDC participants find ways to support each other for an effective movement in the diocese and topics include these learning:

- Helping new Cursillistas form and maintain Friendship Groups
- Conducting School of Leaders meetings
- Organizing joyful Ultreyas
- Productive Secretariat Meetings
- Making personal contacts in the 3-Day
- Implementing authentic Pre-Cursillo and Post-Cursillo


<u>What does the CDC cost? – There are two different registration options.</u>

- Day Participants -- \$100 total fee per person for day participants that <u>do not</u> <u>need overnight accommodations</u>. This includes all meals, materials and fees for meeting space.
- 2. **Overnight Participants** -- \$200 total fee per person for participants that will spend the night at the retreat house. This fee includes all meals, materials and fees for meeting space.

Limited number of rooms and beds. Most bedrooms are shared with common bathrooms on each floor. Priority for overnight accommodations will be given to participants outside the local area. Bedding is provided. Bring your own towels and toiletries. No maid service is provided.
