Catechism of the Catholic Church (Second Edition) Part Four – Christian Prayer Section One – Prayer in the Christian Life Chapter One – The Revelation Of Prayer

ARTICLE 3: IN THE FULLNESS OF TIME

2623 On the day of Pentecost, the Spirit of the Promise was poured out on the disciples, gathered "together in one place."⁹² While awaiting the Spirit, "all these with one accord devoted themselves to prayer."⁹³ The Spirit who teaches the Church and recalls for her everything that Jesus said⁹⁴ was also to form her in the life of prayer.

- ¹When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. **92** Acts 2:1
- 93 Acts 1:14 ¹⁴All these devoted themselves with one accord to prayer, together with some women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and his brothers.
- 94 Cf. Jn. 14:26 ²⁶The Advocate, the holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name he will teach you everything and remind you of all that (I) told you.

2624 In the first community of Jerusalem, believers "devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and the prayers."⁹⁵ This sequence is characteristic of the Church's prayer: founded on the apostolic faith; authenticated by charity; nourished in the Eucharist.

95 Acts 2:42 ⁴²They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the pravers.
