Did you know, that as Catholics, we celebrate Christmas from the Eve of the 24th of December until the Baptism of Jesus, which is January 9th this year. Catholics are encouraged to leave their lights and decorations up and on until next Sunday. This can also be an **opportunity for evangelization**, as neighbors and friends inquire why you still have your decorations up and your lights on. If you really want to celebrate Christmas, as we did before Vatican II, you can leave your tree up until February 2—the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple—40 days after Christmas Day—so that you celebrate the **40 Days of Christmas** (called Christmastide).


