<u>A straw vote for Parish Council</u> elections will take place the weekend of Nov 4-5. The straw vote will take place before and after the weekend Masses. Rand will approach two each of the top winning men and women going down the list until two candidates for each are willing to run in the next weekends voting (Nov 11-12), which will occur during Mass. If you know you will be gone, approach Fr. Rand to get a ballot before the weekend. The man and woman elected serve a term of four years. Please pray and consider who you believe would make good candidates.

Joseph is married with children and attends St. Joseph Church in Beatrice, Nebraska. He is active in his Parish, a Knight of Columbus, owns and operates a business, and is a man of prayer. Day will begin with Mass at 9:00am followed by coffee and rolls, two sessions, prayer time, opportunity for the Sacrament of Reconciliation, lunch and Adoration. The day will end at 2:00pm. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish will provide Coffee/rolls and lunch (token free will offering to help defray the expenses). Please join us

for the whole day or whatever parts you are able to attend, and share the opportunity with others.

The Church provides a great opportunity to help the departed by performing acts of devotion, repentance and charity. These acts provide remission from temporal punishment and are called indulgences. During the Octave of All Saints, (November 1-8) the Church gives us a special opportunity to gain indulgences for the departed. A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is granted each and every day from November 1st to Nov 8th, who devoutly visit a cemetery and there pray, if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from the 1st to the 8th of November; on other days of the year it is partial. On All Souls' Day (November 2nd) A plenary indulgence is granted the faithful who, on All Souls' Day, devoutly visits a church or an oratory and recites an Our Father and the Creed. Requirements for obtaining a plenary indulgence: Do the work while in a state of grace, Receive Sacramental confession within 20 days of the work (several plenary indulgences may be earned per reception), Receive Eucharistic communion (one plenary indulgence may be earned per reception), Pray for the pope's intentions (Our Father and Hail Mary, or other appropriate prayer, is sufficient), Have no attachment to sin (even venial) - i.e., it is sufficient that the Christian makes an act of the will to love God and despise sin. Requirements for a partial indulgence: The work must be done while in a state of grace and with the general intention of earning an indulgence.
