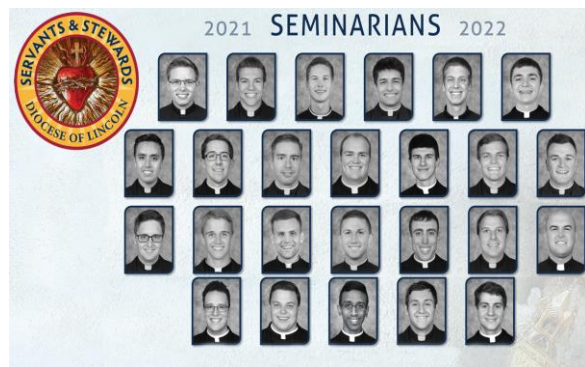

On the bottom of the rack that secures the candles is a blue folder, which holds a "Special Prayer Intentions" sheet. Just write the name of the person that you want special prayers said for. At the end of each month the "Intentions" sheet is picked up and mailed to the Holy Spirit Adoration Sisters (better known as the Pink Sisters) in Lincoln.
