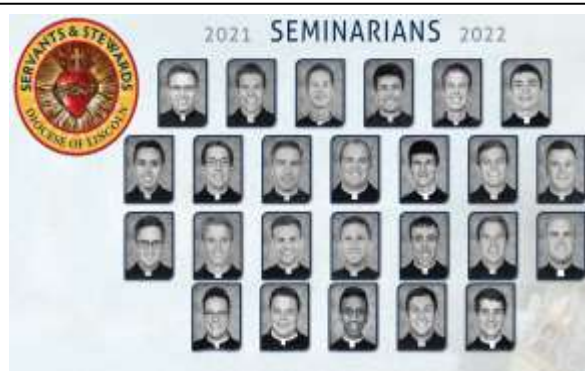

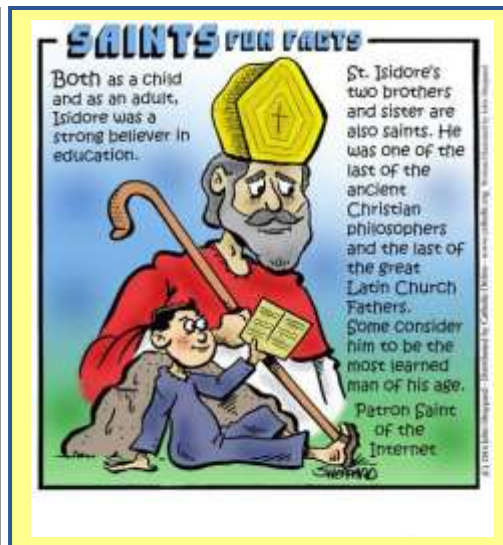

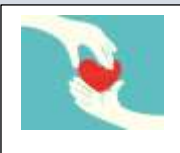
Upcoming Events: Nov. 7-9: Senior Class on Retreat, **Nov. 9:** 2:00pm- JH WR @ Hershey.
