We sought and received further clarification from the USCCB regarding the Immaculate Conception Holy Day of Obligation with respect to Vigil Masses. The guiding principle is that the 2nd Sunday of Advent is a higher ranking feast than the Immaculate Conception (hence the moving the IC in the first place). At any Mass on Sunday evening, whether within or outside of the usual schedule, the Mass setting and readings for the Second Sunday of Advent are used. **The obligation** for Sunday is fulfilled by any Mass Saturday evening through Sunday night. The obligation for the Holy Day is fulfilled by any Mass Sunday evening through Monday night. **In other words**, an individual could attend Mass Sunday morning and have all the prayers and readings for the 2nd Sunday of Advent and fulfill their Sunday obligation; then go to Mass that evening (which would have all the prayers and readings for, again the 2nd Sunday of Advent) and fulfill their obligation for the Immaculate Conception.

December 8th is the Solemnity of the Immaculate <u>Conception</u> and it is a Holy Day of Obligation. Mass will be on Sunday, December 7th at 4:00pm, and Monday, December 8th at 7:00am.

<u>Knights of Columbus</u> will be distributing St. Nicholas bags to children this weekend to celebrate his feast (Dec. 6) and opening our poster contest open to students from Kindergarten to 8th grade.
