From Fr. Karl Millis: Thanks to everyone who prayed for my successful surgery today. The ablation technique worked successfully on stopping the arrhythmia in the section detected. A second arrhythmia was then detected in another area as well (that is more difficult to access), and was treated with a partial ablation, with the hopes that enough scarring was done to it, that it may disappear; or become infrequent enough, that it won't be a problem. I won't know the results of this for 3 or 4 weeks; asking for the special intercession of St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta, (who suffered from heart ailments in the latter years of her life), that the arrhythmia may disappear completely. 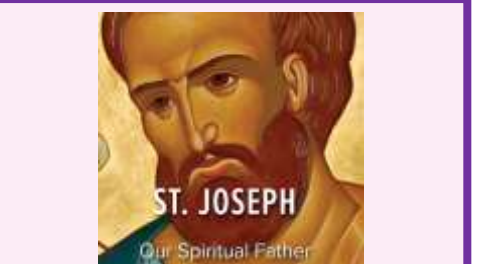
