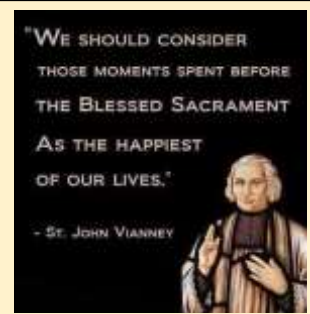

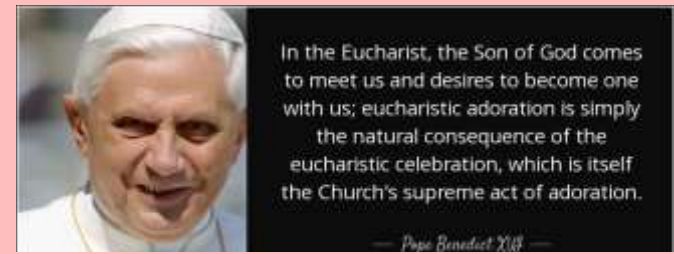


Our Parish will have the **pilgrim icon of St. Joseph**
