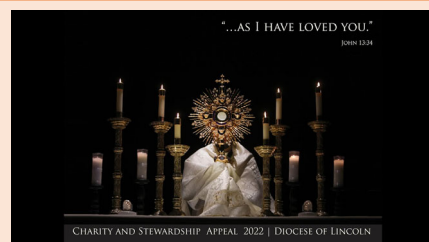

Spirit Catholic Radio Network presents Treasures of the Church—a relics exposition and healing ministry—at Scottsbluff, Sidney, Hastings, Grand Island, Lincoln, Omaha, Nebraska City Hartington from June 17th-June 25th, 2022. More than 150 sacred relics will be on display—some believed to be as old as 2,000 years. Among the treasures are relics of Pope St. John Paul II, St. Therese of Lisieux, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Padre Pio and St. Faustina. In addition, there will be one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world, as well as, a piece of a veil believed to have belonged to Our Lady. Presented by Fr. Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross. Attendees are encouraged to bring their articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members which may be touched to the reliquaries as a means of intercessory prayer. The ministry has had reports of healing among a number of visitors to the exposition. Full tour details, such as location and start times, can be found at spiritcatholicradio.com/. The event is FREE and open to the public.

The Sacrament of Anointing will be available at the end of Mass on June 30. It is available to: any Catholic in a state of grace over the age of 65, a Catholic of any age with a serious surgery in coming weeks or someone diagnosed with a life-threatening illness/disease (if unsure please ask Fr. Rand). At the conclusion of Mass, all wishing to receive the sacrament should form a line (like a Communion line) and proceed forward for the laying of hands and anointing of oil. They are asked to remain in their pews until the concluding prayer and blessing. In these changed times of COVID and other serious threats to health and life, it is hoped that this blessing may impart its peace.
